# What do I do if ICE comes to my workplace?

1. "Do you have a warrant?

2. "Please slip the warrant under the door."



- ◆ Do not open the door!
- ◆ Ask the officer for identification and if he/she has a warrant.
- Read the warrant and check that it has your name, address and is signed by a judge.
- Without this the officer may not enter your home.
